

Frogman hops over to Quay Art in Padstow.





or Leicester-born artist Tim Cotterill, the shiny little frogs found in the secluded woods of his childhood in the English countryside were the beginning of a life-long fascination that has led him to be known as the Frogman. Tim's much-admired bronze sculptures perfectly capture the whimsical character, jewel-like quality and pure joy of these beautiful little creatures.

Quay Art in Padstow, home to a wide range of ceramics, original artworks and limited editions from both local and internationally recognised artists, also houses a collection from the Frogman. As Roger from the gallery explains, "We are delighted to present these captivating, colourful and expressive sculptures so more people can appreciate the creativity and craftsmanship of Tim Cotterill."

These beautifully handcrafted sculptures are highly sought after by collectors. While appearing to have been made from glass,

Tim's frogs are actually incredibly heavy, having been cast in solid bronze. They're created following The Egyptian Wax Method and a six-step process that finally results in the stunning jewel-like patina. There's a fascinating video on Quay Art's website, if you'd like to discover more.

Each Frogman sculpture is individually finished, signed and numbered as part of a world-wide limited edition set. Quay Art will issue a certificate of authenticity and record the sale and limited edition details as proof of your original purchase. The Frogman Sculptures also have an individual number and signature applied to the underside of one of the feet as a permanent, easily recognisable sign of originality.

Roger continues: "We encourage you to visit us at Quay Art to appreciate these stunning sculptures for yourself. And if you come along to our show on Tuesday 22nd September, you can even meet Tim Cotterill, the Frogman, himself!"

You'll learn more about Tim's inspiration and can have him engrave your favourite frog sculpture, as well as viewing the stunning Frogman Collection, including some special frogs released especially for the occasion.
